



## Swim Wear Policy for ALL children enrolled in Swim School

All children under 3 years and older if not fully toilet trained must wear a swimming nappy while using any of our pools.

All children are required to wear close fitting togs during their lesson, either speedo style trunks or briefs for boys and one piece full togs for girls. Please see pictures below.

Children will need to wear goggles for all classes and swimming caps for all lane classes in the outdoor pool. All children with long hair must have it tied back during lessons.

There are many benefits to wearing this type of swim wear during lessons including, better technique, less friction/ drag, increased speed and they are more secure when diving.

We have sourced a supply of chlorine resistant swimwear that you can order through us or you are welcome to buy from elsewhere.

We recommend the use of chlorine resistant fabric for all swim wear used in our pools.
